Ulcerative colitis (UC) is a multifaceted chronic inflammatory bowel disease characterized by unpredictable episodes of remission and relapse.

The clinical course of UC varies widely among patients, with some experiencing mild symptoms and others facing more severe disease burdens. This heterogeneity underscores the need for a precise and individualized treatment approach. Mild-to-moderate ulcerative colitis, while not life-threatening, can significantly diminish a patient's quality of life. Additionally, the unpredictability of symptom exacerbations can lead to psychological distress, social limitations, and work or school absenteeism.

Thus, achieving and maintaining disease control is vital to improving patients' overall well-being. Treat-to-target recognizes the individuality of each patient's disease course and treatment response. It encourages healthcare providers to tailor therapy based on a patient's disease severity, treatment response, and preferences. This approach emphasizes individualized therapy, sets specific treatment goals, and represents a significant step forward in optimizing the management of ulcerative colitis to improve patient outcomes and quality of life.
